CARLINE REMINDERS

- Per TN state law, it is illegal to be on your phone in the carline. Thank you in advance for keeping our children safe and staying off your phone!
- The carline entrance is on Sequoyah Drive. The carline should be fed from a lineup on Martin Drive (behind campus) OR down Sequoyah Drive toward Cherokee Dr.
- Sequoyah Drive is blocked from Indian Lake Road. If you are coming from Indian Lake Road, you should pass Sequoyah, pass in front of school, turn Right on Crosby Drive, and then turn right on Martin Drive to go behind the school and enter the carline.
- Our carline is two lanes. *You must stay in whatever lane you choose, and you must exit campus by turning left from the left lane and right from the right lane.*
- Please be sure you have your decal displayed and your child's name is written legibly and is clearly visible to the attendant. The attendant will radio your child's name to the waiting area and your child will be assigned to stand at the labeled stations numbered 1-8.
- Pull as far forward as possible. For safety, your child will be signaled to approach your car when a staff member blows the whistle. Please DO NOT call out the window and ask your child to get in the car. They are to wait for the whistle.
- For safety and efficiency, it is our preference that all children buckle themselves in and that you remain in the driver's seat. However, if your child is still working on this skill, you may quickly jump out and assist.
- We will have plenty of assistance to guide our younger and new students safely to the cars.
- When all 8 stations have children verified as being safely in all vehicles, the very front attendant will turn their sign from STOP to SLOW. At this time cars will begin to move again.
